 - PM restrictive practices s/w transfer rules

Free ICT Europe – results?

- Commission have told us that there are 'regulatory options' that could be pursued as a solution
- The European Commission at the end of this month will launch a proposal for the Single Market Strategy
 - A key aspect of this is an EU ICT Pact which will address how ICT services are to be provided
 - Leaked draft prepared by the Commission Directorate-General suggest that the initiative comes as a result of our successful engagement with DG GROW
- MEP's identified for key market support (Germany, UK, France, Italy)
- FIE is now established as a key contributor to the debate
- Struggled to get industry on-board
