




TOP LOCATION FOR TALENT

R&D INCENTIVES

- + More than \$14 billion is spent annually on R&D in Ontario, home to almost half of Canada's full-time R&D personnel.
- + Combined federal and provincial R&D tax credits can reduce the after-tax cost of every \$100 in R&D spending between \$37 and \$61.
- + Incentives include a mix of both refundable and non-refundable tax credits.
- No minimum or maximum spend required on R&D.
- More costs qualify for R&D incentives here than in the United States – including wages, materials, overhead and contract expenses.
